Associate of Science in Respiratory Therapy To
Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Care Completion Program

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Science (AS) in Respiratory Therapy degree at Ivy Tech Community College (ITCC) and leads to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Respiratory Care degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

Applying to the IvyTech2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Ivy Tech, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Ivy Tech.

Degree Requirements for Ivy Tech

To earn a degree at Ivy Tech a student must successfully complete the required number of credits for the degree, attain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the required technical and general education courses, and complete at least 15 degree credits in the curriculum as a regular student of Ivy Tech.

Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU. In addition, students must meet the admission requirements to the Respiratory Care Completion Program listed below.

- Applicants must be a graduate of a CoARC accredited program.
- Have a GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for all transferable college work.
- Have a current Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) credential from the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC). Credits can be earned for specific NKU courses for students with credentials such as ACCS, NPS, RPFT, and SDS. Additional information is given at the end of this document.

- Meet all eligibility requirements for admissions into NKU.
- All academic work must be evaluated by NKU Admissions Office and the Respiratory Care Program Director.

This major is completed online. Courses are offered in seven-week formats. Tuition for online accelerated programs differs from face-to-face tuition. Scholarship pricing is available to Ivy Tech students who choose to enroll in the fully online program. Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0 and meet all requirements for the major. A minor is not required for this major.
