TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate of Applied Science in Nursing at Sinclair College to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing – R.N. to B.S.N. at Northern Kentucky University

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Nursing degree at Sinclair College and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

Degree Requirements for Sinclair College

To earn a degree at Sinclair College, a student must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, and earn a minimum of 20 credit hours at Sinclair College.

Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

Admission Requirements for the R.N. to B.S.N. program:

- Be fully admitted to NKU as a degree-seeking student.
- Submit a separate application to the R.N. to B.S.N. program.
- Submit to the Office of Admissions:
 - o Official transcripts from an associate degree in nursing.
 - o Official transcripts from all postsecondary work completed.
- Possess a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Complete the following prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C in each course. Courses in parentheses are Sinclair College courses.
 - o ENG 101 (ENG 1101) and ENG 102 (ENG 1201)
 - BIO 208/208L (BIO 1141) and BIO 209/209L (BIO 1242)
 - o BIO 202/202L (BIO 2205)
 - o PSY 100 (PSY 1100)
 - o PSY 321 (PSY 2200) or EDU 300 (PSY 2242)
 - PHI 220 or PHI 200 (PHI 2206)
- Hold current, unrestricted R.N. licensure within the first semester of admission to R.N. to B.S.N. program. Proof of R.N. licensure in state of practice is mandatory prior to enrollment in any nursing course.

This major can be completed online. Courses are offered in seven-week formats.

Tuition for online accelerated programs differs from face-to-face tuition. Scholarship pricing is available to Sinclair College students who choose to enroll in the fully online program. Visit our website for more information about the <u>Nursing Accelerated Online program</u>.

Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0, earn a C or higher in all major courses, and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major. A minor is not required for this major.

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National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN)

A requirement for admission to the R.N. to B.S.N. program is an active registered nursing license. In order to obtain a nursing license, nurses must take and pass the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN). Validation for passing the exam will be to verify a current license with the state board of nursing in which the student is licensed.

Students with an active registered nursing license will receive credit for NKU courses according to the chart below after they are enrolled in the R.N. to B.S.N. program.
