# TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate of Arts in Liberal Arts at UC Clermont College to a Bachelor of Science in Sociology at Northern Kentucky University

#### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Arts (AA) in Liberal Arts degree at UC Clermont College and leads to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Sociology degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

#### Degree Requirements for UC Clermont

To earn a degree at UC Clermont, a student must complete a minimum of 61 credit hours, attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, and earn a minimum of 20 credit hours at the institution awarding the degree.

#### **Admission Requirements for NKU**

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

This major can be completed face-to-face or online. If completed fully online, courses are offered in seven-week formats. Tuition for online accelerated programs differs from face-to-face tuition. Scholarship pricing is available to UC Clermont students who choose to enroll in the fully online program. #### **Degree Requirements for NKU**

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for courses that count towards the major as well as an overall GPA of 2.0. Students must complete a focus or minor as indicated on the pathway.
