

NKU Chase Application Checklist

- Create Law School Admissions Council (LSAC) Account
 - Register and pay for Credential Assembly Service (CAS)
 - Send transcripts from all undergraduate, graduate, and professional schools attended
 - Send two (2) letters of recommendation
 - Pay for completed report to be sent to NKU Chase
 - Register and pay for Law School Admissions Test (LSAT)
 - LSAT scores cannot be more than five years old from the date of application
 - Order study materials from LSAC store (optional)
 - Study for and take LSAT
- Fill out NKU Chase application
 - Write and attach Personal Statement
 - Write and attach Resume
 - Write and attach Character & Fitness explanations (if applicable)
 - Write and attach Diversity Statement (optional)
 - Write and attach Evening Division Statement (if applicable)
 - Double-check all information in application
 - Pay application fee (\$40)
 - Submit application
