PLT is a national program, which consists of a guide with 100 very detailed lesson plans that have been aligned with state and national science, math, and other subject area standards.

The goal of the lessons in PLT are to develop students' awareness, appreciation, skills, and commitment to address environmental issues; to provide a framework for students to apply scientific processes and higher order thinking skills to resolve environmental problems; to help students acquire an appreciation and tolerance of diverse viewpoints on environmental issues and develop attitudes and actions based on analysis and evaluation of the available information; to encourage creativity, originality, and flexibility to resolve environmental problems and issues; and to inspire and empower students to become responsible, productive, and participatory members of society.
