

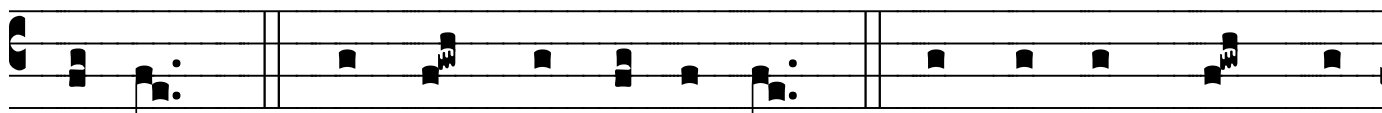

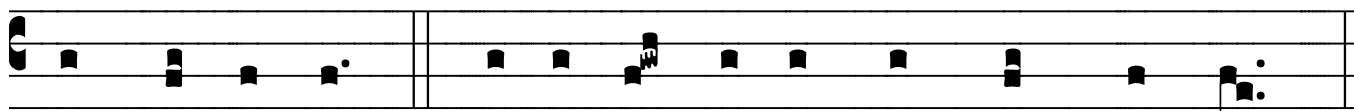
The presider greets the people and bids them to prayer, during which the people respond:



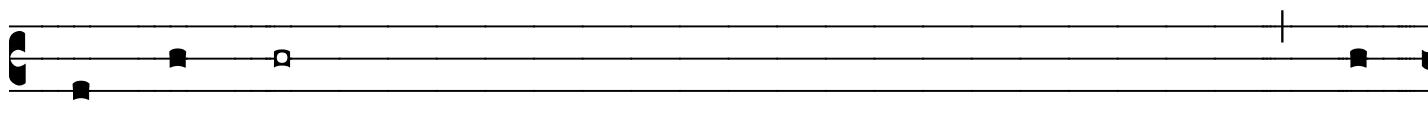
