NKU Research Foundation sponsors the following student funding opportunities, which encourage and support students to pursue research and creative projects that will contribute new insights in their chosen field.

- The Student Undergraduate Research & Creativity Award (SURCA) provides up to \$500 per undergraduate student to complete a research project or creative activity.
- The Summer Undergraduate Research/Creativity Fellowship (SURF) provides a fellowship of \$2,500 and a supplies allowance up to \$500 per undergraduate student.
- The Graduate Student Research Grant (GSRG) provides up to \$750 per graduate student to complete a research project or creative activity.
