### **PARKING PASSES! GET'EM WHILE THEY'RE HOT!!**

Starting July 16, 2007 students can purchase their new NKU Parking Permit for the **new** school year. Please visit website at [www.parking.nku.edu](http://www.parking.nku.edu) and click on "permit purchase" to order your new permit. All permits must be paid for in advance.

#### **Permits ordered via the web:**

Permits ordered **on-line by credit card before** August 10th will be mailed to the address selected on your on-line permit purchase form. Permits ordered from August 11th thru August 17th will only be available for pick up in the lobby of the University Center from 8am – 12noon during the first week of classes. If you wish to pick up your permit after 12noon please visit our office at 419 Johns Hill Rd between the hours of 8am–4:30pm, Monday – Friday. **Beginning the second week of classes all permits must be picked up at Parking Services.**

#### **Permits ordered by mail:**

If you would like to pay by check or money order, please print off the "permit purchase by mail" form and send it to Parking Services, 419 Johns Hill Rd, Highland Heights, Kentucky 41099 by Monday, August 08. Due to the heavy volume of permit requests that we receive by mail, all permit purchases by check or money order after August 08 have to be made in person at Parking Services.

If you have outstanding parking fines your permit order will not be processed until all fines have been cleared. Parking fines can be paid on-line using the "citation payment" link.

Any student that pays for their parking permit on-line with a credit card will automatically be entered into the Parking Services Raffle. Two lucky winners will receive full reimbursement for their parking permit.
