My logo is built upon three cursive J's, standing for my name, James. I opted for cursive after failing to make a good logo with normal J's countless times. The J's resemble a sort of trefoil knot in its design but with the extra loops at the ends of them, though it is more of a link of 3. The colors of the J's (red, blue, and yellow) represent the tri-colorable nature of trefoil knots or a link group of 3. The J's are linked together as a set of Borromean rings, with every J having an overlap on the very top of the stack, the middle, and being at the bottom. They are more complex Borromean rings as the rings themselves are more in line with unknots with R1 Reidemeister moves.
