Loving Jesus as we need and should do obliges us to be an expected bother at times. After near thirty years doing my best to serve and love those in need I am forced by the cost of living to ask your help in helping a twenty-eight year old finish her nursing school program. Remina Belle-Amour is an excellent student, a pleasing moral Christian, and would greatly benefit by your financial help. She will need \$1000 per term for the next three terms to finish, not including her living expenses. The cruel irony is that she should have been finished now, but the government imposed a fourth year to her program.

Remina hasn't anyone else to help her. Her father abandoned the mother and five children, and her mother has had a stroke and is bed-ridden. I've been supplying her with shoes, food, and every sort of necessity while she completed the first three years of school; due to my current circumstances, I haven't the means to continue supporting her alone.

[Ivy showed me some of Remina's grades from 2004: she was above the mean of her class in 34 out of 36 subjects, and often significantly higher (e.g. her score of 85 to the mean of 53.88; or 73 versus mean of 49.49). Her summary comments equate to "Great!!" – Andy]
