Abstract: The Texas Instruments TI-73 Explorer calculator is designed for use by middle schools students (and teachers). In this hands-on workshop, participants will explore real-world problems, connected to core content, though typically inaccessible without the use of appropriate technology. Features of the TI-73 that will be used are the dice command with plots (to explore statistics), the choosing command with Pascal's Triangle (to explore probability) and the constant feature (to explore algebra).
