General Chemistry Laboratory Safety Presentation

During the first laboratory period for General Chemistry Laboratory I and Π the following items are to be discussed with the students.

- 1. Location and use of each of the following:
 - a) Safety shower
 - b) Eye wash station
 - c) Glass waste container(s)
 - d) Master shut off valve for natural gas
 - e) Emergency power cut off valve
 - f) Fire extinguisher
 - g) Fire blanket
 - h) First aid kit
 - i) Emergency telephone Dial 7777 or 911; caller should state the nature of the emergency, give the location of the emergency, and the name of the caller.
- 2. Directions for exiting the building in case of a fire or fire drill.

 Exit the room (422, 426) and turn right, use stairs to go to second floor and exit onto the plaza, move away from the building.
- 3. Go over some of the most likely safety violations:
 - a) do not eat or drink anything in the lab
 - b) wear safety glasses at all times
 - c) it is recommended that student's do not wear contact lenses in the lab. There is some evidence that certain vapors and liquids can get trapped between the lens and the eye.
 - d) wear proper clothing (no open toe shoes; have hair tied behind your head)
 - e) report ALL accidents to your instructor
 - f) do not hesitate to activate the emergency alarm or call public safety at 7777 or 911
- 4. Students are advised to inform instructors of any medical condition they may have that could place themselves or others in harmful situations.
- 5. Inform students that ACS Safety Guides are available from the chemistry stockroom.
