Semester Enrollment Profile - Spring 2000 (Comparisons with Spring 1999, unless otherwise noted)

Enrollment

- ! **Total- Headcount-** decrease, -0.4% (n=47), **FTE** increase, 3.0%.
Overall decrease in first-time students, -13% (n=71).
- ! **Undergraduate- Headcount-** increase, 0.2% (n=20); **FTE** increase, 3.6%.
 - **Degree-Seeking- Headcount-** increase, 1.0% (n=95); **FTE** increase, 4.2%.
 - T Increase from improved retention among all classifications of degree-seeking undergraduates.
 - T First-time freshmen decrease, -20.8% (n=58); **FTE** decrease, -12.7%.
 - T First-time transfer, decrease, -9.9% (n=33).
 - T Ohio Reciprocity: 519 compared to 528 in SP99.
 - T Indiana Reciprocity: 327 compared to 297 in SP99.
 - **Non-Degree- Headcount-** decrease, 13.5% (n=75).
- ! **Graduate- Headcount-** decrease, -4.5% (n=36); **FTE** No change.
 - **Degree-Seeking- Headcount-** decrease, -11.1% (n=72); **FTE** decrease, -6.0%.
 - Declines are in Elementary Education (n=76) and Secondary Education (n=22).
 - Strong growth in MS in Technology from **19** in SP99 to **30** in SP2000.
 - New MS in Computer Science, **10** enrolled.
 - **Non-Degree- Headcount-** increase, 22.5% (n=36); **FTE** increase, 27.9%.
 - Increase in Education Rank1 and Fifth Year Certification programs, 61.2% (n=30), and in unclassified graduate students, 9.2% (n=10).
- ! **Chase College of Law- Headcount-** decrease, -8.8% (n=31).
- ! **Community Location Initiatives.**
 - -Grant county: 81 students in 10 classes: SP99; 64 in 10 classes.
 - -Urban Learning Center: 55 students in 4 classes; SP99: 54 students in 3 classes.

Gender and Race

- ! **Undergraduate-** Female enrollment percentage increased from 58.8% to 59.6% (n=87).
Male enrollment dropped by -1.7% (n=67).
- ! **African American-** increased by 9.3% (n=31). Account for 3.3% of total enrollment.
 - KY resident African American enrollment increased by 8.5%(n=17); account for 2.6% of KY resident students.
- ! **Non-resident Alien on Student Visa-** increased 8.0% (n=9), represent 1.1% of enrollment.

Credit Hours and ACT

- ! **Remedial Level Credit Hours-** After a 3 yr. decline, an increase of 148 SCH over SP99.
 - Other Lower Level SCH increased by 5.1% (n=3,749).
 - Upper Level SCH increased by 0.3% (n=113).
 - Graduate SCH increased by 2.4% (n=71).
 - Overall student course loads increased slightly.
- ! **ACT Composite-** Same as SP99 overall. Bachelor's Level: 21.6 compared to (SP99) 21.9.
Associate's Level: 20.2 compared to SP99 20.6, Univ. Studies: 16.8 compared to (SP99) 16.9).
- ! **Persistence (percent returning from Fall 1999 to Spring 2000)-** All first-time Freshmen: 84.3% compared to F98/SP99: 81%. Full-time: 86.1% compared to F98/SP99: 83%; Part-time: 73.6% compared to F98/SP99: 59.5%.
 - **African American First-Freshmen-** 89.5% compared to F98/SP99: 84%.
 - **KY Plan African American-** 90.6% (n=48 of 53) compared to F98/SP99: 90.1% (n=38 of 42).
 - **Bachelor's Degree-** 87.3% compared to F98/SP99: 84.8%.
 - **Associate's Degree-** 82.7% compared to F98/SP99: 81.5%.
 - **University Studies-** 78.3% compared to F98/SP99: 72.4%.

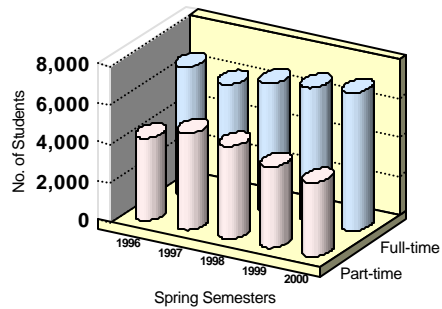
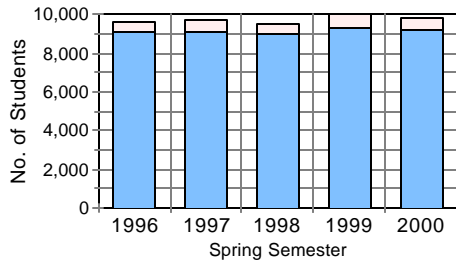
Headcount and FTE Students



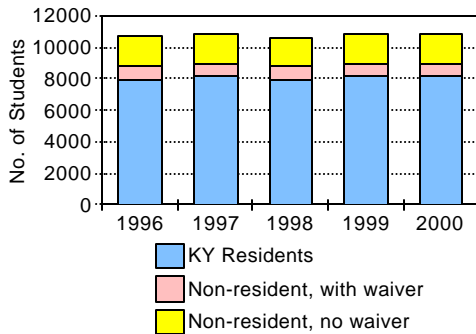
First-Time Students at Program Level



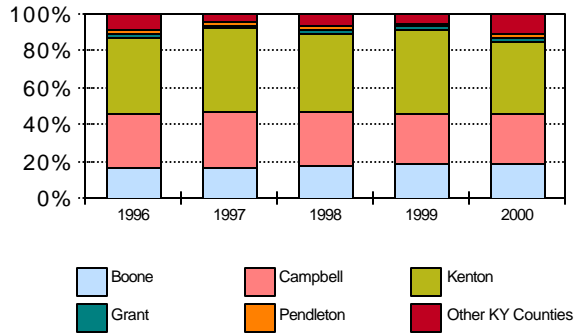
Full-Time and Part-Time



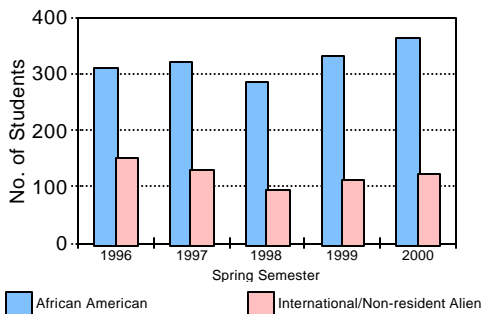
Residency Status
