Semester Enrollment Profile - Spring 2002 (Comparisons with Spring 2001, unless otherwise noted)

Enrollment (This semester's enrollment is third highest in NKU history, behind Fall 2001 and Fall 2000.)

! **Total- Headcount-** increase, 7.3% (n=825); **FTE:** increase, 9.9% (n=786).
First-time students at all levels, increase, 8.6% (n=46)

! **Undergraduate- Headcount-** increase, 7.4% (n=744); **FTE:** increase, 9.3%.
Degree-Seeking- Headcount- increase, 7.5% (n=710); **FTE:** increase, 9.6%, Avg. Cr.hr load- 12.3
Increase from improved retention among undergrad classes.
First-time freshmen increase, 32.9% (n=77); **FTE:** increase, 40.4%, Avg. Cr.hr load- 11.5
First-time transfer, increase, 21.8% (n=64).
Ohio Reciprocity: 392 compared to 404 in SP01. Continuing decline from 519 in SP00.
Indiana Reciprocity: 398 compared to 329 in SP01.
Non-Degree- Headcount- increase, 5.9% (n=34).

! **Graduate- Headcount-** increase, 8.8% (n=77); **FTE:** increase, 21.5%.
Degree-Seeking- Headcount- increase, 11.4% (n=79); **FTE:** increase, 26.8%. Avg. Cr.Hr.- 5.3
First-time degree seeking, increase, 12.7% (n=14). Continuing students, increase, 11.1%.
Non-Degree- Headcount- decrease, 2 students.

! **Chase College of Law- Headcount-** increase, 1 student.

! **Community Location Initiatives & Distance Learning Registrations**
-Grant county: 115 students in 16 classes: SP01; 68 in 10 classes.
-Urban Learning Center: 73 students in 8 classes; SP01: 39 students in 3 classes.
-Distance learning: KTLN- 47 (6 classes); KYVU- 42 (2 classes); NKU web based- 294 (13 classes).

Gender and Race

! **Undergraduate-** Female enrollment percentage drop from 59.8% to 59.4%; 7,178 women, 4,916 men.
! **African American-** increased by 21.3% (n=94). Account for 4.4% of total enrollment.
KY resident African American enrollment increased by 23.8%(n=61); account for 3.0% of KY resident students.
! **Non-resident Aliens on Student Visa-** increased 24.1% (n=34), represent 1.4% of enrollment.

Credit Hours and ACT

! **Credit Hours**, Remedial level increased.14.6% (630 sch).
Other Lower Level sch increased by 9.9% (7,924 sch).
Upper Level sch increased by 8.1% (2,772 sch).
Graduate sch increased by 19.9% (709 sch).
Overall student course loads increased over SP01, except for non-degree Ugrads..
! **ACT Composite-** 18.7 compared to SP01: 18.8. Bachelor's Level: 21.0 compared to SP01: 21.0.
Associate's Level: 19.1 compared to SP01: 20.6. Univ. Studies: 16.5 compared to SP01: 16.3.

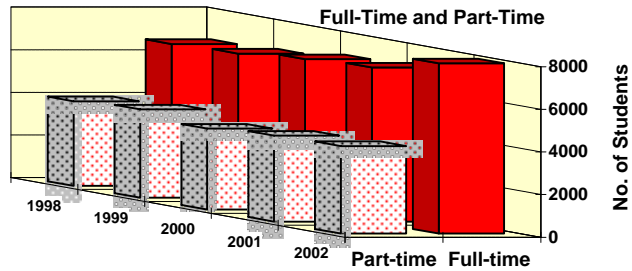
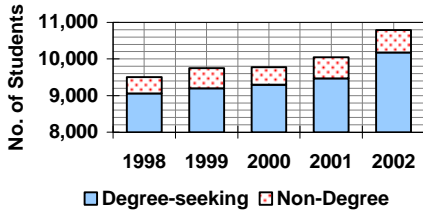
Headcount and FTE Students



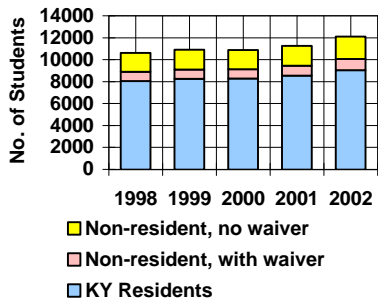
First-Time Students at Program Level



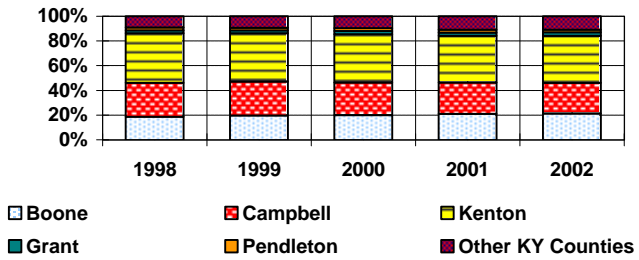
Undergraduate Enrollments Degree and Non-Degree



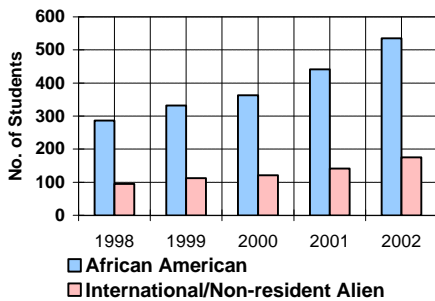
Residency Status
