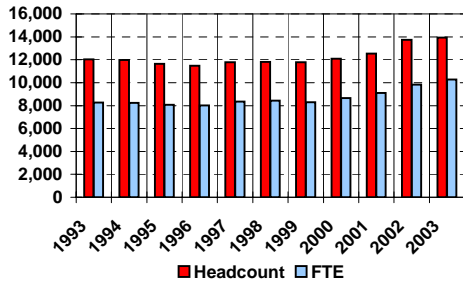

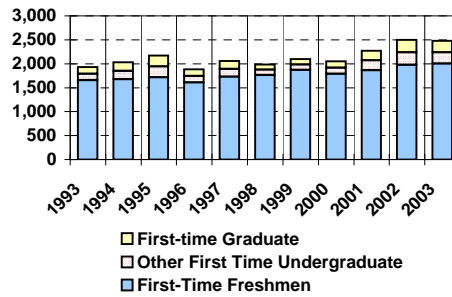

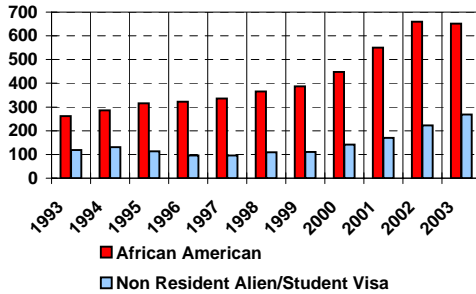
Total Headcount & FTE



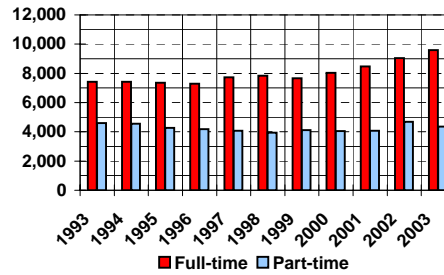
First Time Students at Program Level



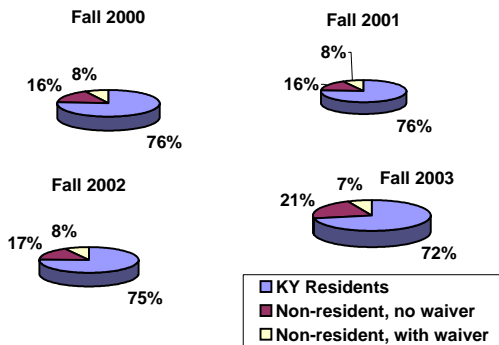
African American & International Students on Student Visa



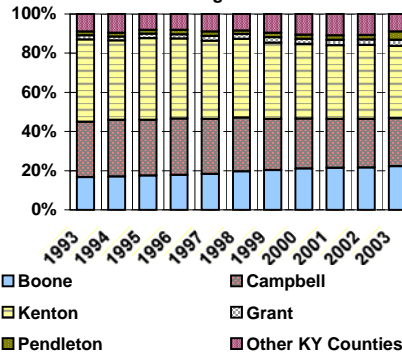
Full-time & Part-time



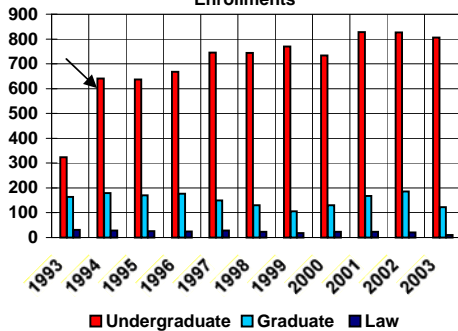
Residency Status



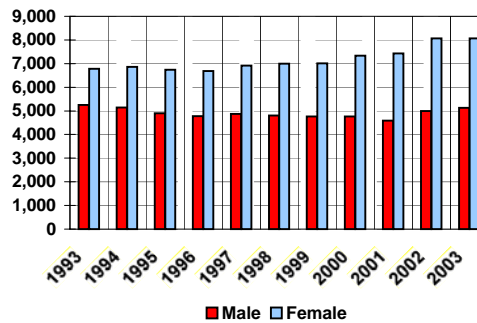
Kentucky Resident Students Origin Counties
