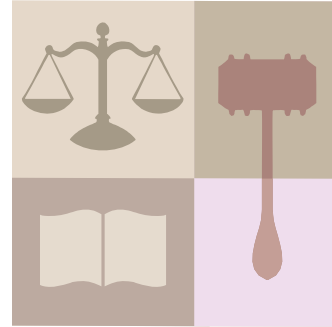

Additional Graduation Requirements:

- A. Any and all remedial/developmental courses **MUST** be successfully completed.
- B. Final Residency: Last 20 Hours **MUST** be completed at NKU.
- C. A minimum of 66 hours at a 2.0 GPA or above **MUST** be completed for the ACJS.
- D. Program Certification **MUST** be completed in department and submitted to Registrar by deadline.
- E. Application for Degree Candidacy **MUST** be submitted to Registrar, AC 301, by deadline.
- F. Graduation fee **MUST** be paid to Bursar, AC 235, by deadline.
