Application Deadlines:

Official graduation application deadlines are published in the University Catalog, University Academic Calendar, and the online Registration Guide.

Graduation Requirements:

In addition to major/minor/area of concentration program requirements, students must satisfy general education, university, residency, hours earned, and grade point average requirements specified in the applicable University Catalog. Graduation Checklist

Academic Checklist:

- General Education Requirements (as outlined in your governing catalog).
- Major Area of Study Requirements (as outlined in your governing catalog).
- Secondary Area of Study Requirements - Minor and/or Area of Concentration (as outlined in your governing catalog).

Residency Requirements:

- Associate Degree: Last 20 credit hours completed at NKU.
- Bachelor's Degree: Last 30 credit hours completed at NKU.
- Bachelor's Degree: Minimum 25% of coursework completed at NKU.

Total Hours Earned Requirement

- Associate Degree: Minimum 64 credit hours at 2.0 GPA or above or as required by degree program.
- Bachelor's Degree: Minimum 128 credit hours at 2.0 GPA or above or as required by degree program.
- Upper Division Requirement for Bachelor's Degree: 45 credit hours at 300 level or above.

Note: Additional requirements may apply depending on your program of study.
