In addition to major/minor/area of concentration program requirements, students must satisfy general education, university, residency, hours earned, and grade point average requirements specified in the applicable University Catalog. Graduation Checklist

Academic Checklist:

Residency Requirements:

- Associate Degree: Last 20 credit hours completed at NKU.
- Bachelor's Degree: Last 30 credit hours completed at NKU. Minimum 25% of coursework completed at NKU.

Total Hours Earned Requirement

- Associate Degree: Minimum 60 semester hours
GPA must be 2.0 or higher or as required by degree program
- Bachelor's Degree: Minimum 120 semester hours
GPA must be 2.0 or higher or as required by degree program

- Upper Division Requirement for Bachelor's Degree: 45 credit hours at 300 level or above.

Note: Additional requirements may apply depending on your program of study.
