Curriculum Plan Guidelines

Overall Goal:

Develop a plan to apply your learning during the course to your classroom teaching. This plan should align the content you will teach to the Kentucky core content for assessment which is appropriate for the grade level(s) you teach. This plan could involve such applications as a series of lessons, the development of learning centers, the development of course materials to supplement teaching, or involving your students in a field trip.

Due Date:

A general description of your curriculum plan will be due by Wednesday, July 16, 2004. Grades will be submitted by July 23, 2004.

Please follow the guidelines below when developing your curriculum plan, using the headings as provided.

Cover Page should include:

- Title of Course & Course Number
- Title of Curriculum
- Grade Level(s) Taught
- Subject Area(s) Taught
- Name
- School and District
- County

Your plan should include the following (please use underlined words as headings):

- General description of curriculum plan
- Core content for assessment addressed
- Materials: identification of handouts, hands-on materials, etc.
- Procedures you plan to use to implement your curriculum project
- Definition/Explanation of concept/skill that students will learn
- Assessment methods of student learning. Describe the method(s) you will use to assess student learning.
- References used to develop curriculum plan
