

# BFA Auditions & Interviews

**This year's auditions for current and incoming students applying for the BFA program will take place on:**

**Monday, April 28<sup>rd</sup>  
3:00 to 6:00pm  
NKU Stauss Theatre  
Fine Arts Building**

**Following are the requirements for students applying for the BFA in:**

**Acting:** Prepare two contrasting monologues, not to exceed 3 minutes total.

**Musical Theatre:** 2 Contrasting Songs not to exceed 90 seconds each.

**Design/Tech:** Be prepared to present your portfolio. It may contain both class assignments and realized production work. Contact Mike King if you need technical or computer support in order to present your portfolio (cd, dvd, powerpoint etc.)

**Playwriting:** Submit 2 writing samples to Ken Jones by April 16<sup>th</sup>, in preparation for your interview on the 28<sup>th</sup>.

**Stage Management:** Bring a prompt script and other materials if you have stage managed a show. If not, bring some sort of documentation that demonstrates your organizational skills.

**Dance:** You will be asked to perform a prepared solo dance for the committee. You should present at least 1 minute of dance and no longer than 3 minutes. Bring a CD of your own accompaniment, containing only your music. See Jane Green for more information.

**All applicants should bring a resume, and if available a picture.  
A short interview may follow your audition.**

**If you plan to attend the Audition/Interview, you must submit a letter of application to Mike King c/o the Department of Theatre and Dance, Northern Kentucky University, Highland Heights, KY 41099 by April 16th. This letter should briefly state why you are interested in pursuing the BFA degree, and what your past training and experience in theatre has been.
