### I. POLICY STATEMENT

Northern Kentucky University (NKU) is a tobacco-free campus.

Tobacco use at all University owned, operated, and leased properties is covered by this policy. Tobacco products are therefore prohibited in all interior/exterior building space, outside ground areas, walkways and parking structures, indoor/outdoor athletic facilities, and vehicles.

Numerous products are prohibited by this campus policy. They include, but are not limited to, the following:

- cigarettes
- cigars
- pipes
- hookah-smoked products
- oral tobacco such as spit/spitless, smokeless, chew, and snuff products
- products that contain tobacco flavoring or simulate tobacco use, such as electronic cigarettes

Violations of this policy will be addressed by the appropriate administrative departments. Concerns about tobacco use will be respectfully addressed.
