INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT) ADVISORY COUNCIL

Purpose:

Provides a forum for a representative body of faculty and staff to advise the Office of Information Technology (OIT) on academic and business activities

Charge:

- Explore how technology may be used to further the mission of the university
- Recommend solutions to challenges being posed that technology can aid

Membership Guidelines:

Membership is composed of representatives from each college, the Council of Chairs, Staff Congress, Faculty Senate and various university business offices.

Each year Deans appoint representative members for their respective colleges, and business offices have the opportunity to continue membership or appoint new members.

Total membership annually is approximately 30 members.

Membership Appointment:

ITAC members are appointed by Deans, Faculty Senate, Staff Congress, and area Vice Presidents.

Membership Terms:

The chair of ITAC is elected for a two (2)-year term which is renewable if acceptable by the committee.

All other members are appointed to the committee on an annual basis.

Frequency of Meetings: Monthly

Expected Lifespan: Ongoing

Reporting Requirements:

ITAC makes recommendations to IT, possibly to the Provost, and possibly to the Information Technology Policy Council
