Purpose:

Develops initiatives and programs to support the institution's primary strategic goal of promoting, enhancing, and improving student success.

Charge:

- Identify best practices for student success, both internal and external, and explore replication of such practices at NKU.
- Identify obstacles or institutional barriers that would impede students' timely progression towards a degree.
- Recommend strategies that will support and improve student success, based on data generated by the Data Team and other sources.
- Recommend data inquiries to the Data Team, Institutional Research, and other university entities.
- Continue faculty development workshops related to student success, e.g., the Faculty Retention Workshops, a series of presentations that disseminate emerging data and engage faculty in ongoing discussions around student success.

Membership Guidelines:

Members are nominated by their college Dean or Vice President.

Membership Appointment:

Appointments are made by the Provost & Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Membership Terms: Ongoing

Frequency of Meetings: Typically once a month

Expected Lifespan: Ongoing

Reporting Requirements:

The Council reports to the Provost & Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Operating Procedures:

 The Council establishes an initiative and develops recommendations or a framework for the initiative. The initiative is approved by consensus and forwarded to the Provost & Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs for vetting, who informs the co-chairs how to proceed.

Relationship to Other Committees:

Subgroup leading the Retention Workshops for faculty and any other departments/programs that may be impacted by recommendations or initiatives

Typical Date of Membership Turnover:

Turnover is atypical but depends on teaching and workload

Responsible Office:

The Co-Chairs share responsibility for the Council. The Co-Chairs meet once or twice a month, in addition to email communications, to establish priorities and management.
