Clinical Mental Health Counseling: For the academic year of 2017 - 2018, there were 13 graduates of NKU's Clinical Mental Health Counseling program. Our graduates consistently achieve high pass rates on licensing examinations. The pass rate for graduates taking the NCE examination in 2017 was 100%. Of the admitted students, 90% graduate from the program in the expected time period and 90% of those program graduates responding to surveys who are actively seeking jobs are employed.

School Counseling: For the academic year of 2017 - 2018, there were 13 graduates of NKU's School Counseling program. Our graduates consistently achieve high pass rates on licensing examinations. Of the admitted students, 90% graduate from the program in the expected time period and 85% of those program graduates responding to surveys who are actively seeking jobs are employed.

Approximately 33 students are enrolled in School Counseling program and 54 in the Clinical Mental Health Counseling program. Of the total number enrolled, 60 are female and 15 are male. Of those students, 12 are outside the Caucasian demographic. More than 90% of accepted students graduate in the expected time period, three years for full-time students in school counseling and three and one-half years for clinical mental health counseling. Courses accommodate both part-time and full-time students. Our program serves populations from Indiana, Kentucky, and Ohio as well as several students from outside our tri-state region.
