## Program Data Point 11. Student Clinical Site Evaluation

Students' Overall Perception of Site Supervision

In Spring 2016, the faculty created and offered a survey in which students had the opportunity to evaluate their site experiences. In Fall 2017, faculty edited the survey to include more concise questions regarding the site supervision and the overall site experience. Faculty piloted the updated survey beginning at the end of Fall 2017 and will continue to revise it.




Figure 1. Students' Overall Perception of Site Supervision

In Figures 1, 2, and 3 below, students' ratings of their site supervision, practice opportunities, and overall site experience are included from Spring 2016. Overall, students rate their site supervision experience as both adequate and effective. Students rate their practice opportunities and overall site experiences as moderately to very satisfactory.







Figure 3. Students' Overall Satisfaction with the Site Experience
