

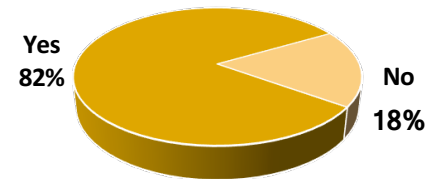

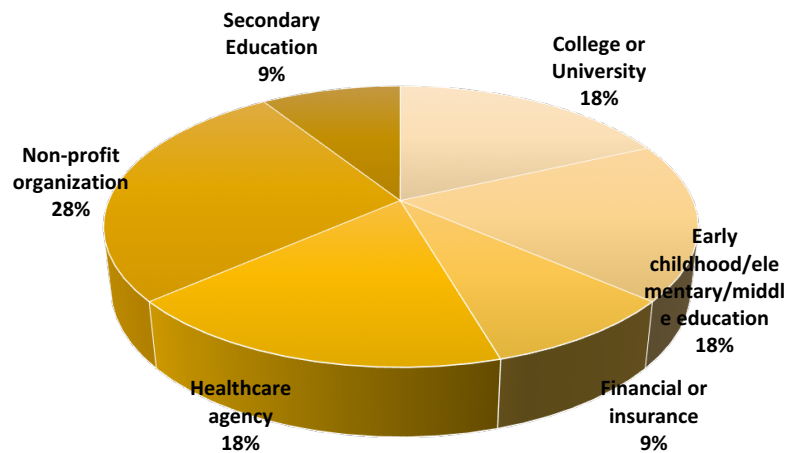

Degree Required to Hold Position

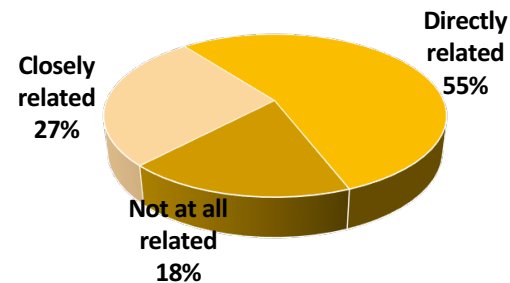

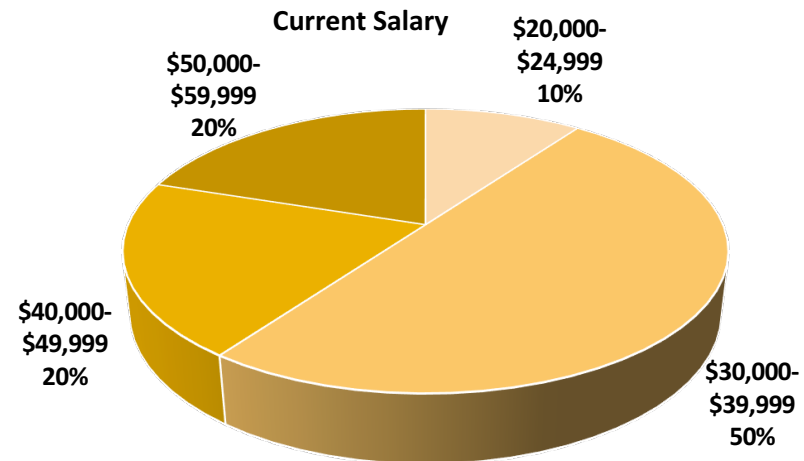

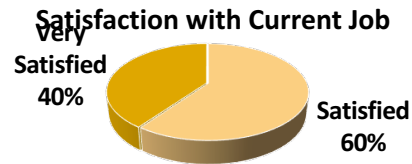
