ADMISSION CRITERIA

Requirements for admission to the Master in Arts in Education: Teacher as Leader as defined by the appropriate catalog include but not limited to:

1. Bachelor’s degree from an accredited institution with a minimum 2.5 GPA
2. Official Transcripts from all Institutions
3. Graduate Record Examination (waived if undergraduate GPA was 3.0 or higher)
4. Statement of Professional Goals
5. Three (3) letters of recommendation
6. Copy of teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
7. Signed Teacher as Leader Admission Agreement

CURRICULUM CRITERIA

Individual Competence Development*: Zero to six (0-6) hours Any MA.Ed candidate who has never taken courses in the teaching of reading and introduction to special education will be required to do so as a part of this program.

Professional Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours required) At least 15 hours must be taken in courses 600 or above.

Concentration Core: Twelve (12) semester hours (with prior approval) and in accordance with program requirements or to strengthen the content/concentration of the student. Additional hours may be required to complete selected endorsement.

Elective Core: Three (3) semester hours.
