ADMISSION CRITERIA

Student must meet requirements for admission to Master of Arts in Education: Teacher as a Leader. Requirements defined by the appropriate catalog and outlined on the program curriculum contract.

- 1 Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a minimum 2.5 GPA
- 2. Official transcripts from all institutions.
- 3. Graduate Record Examination (waived if undergrad GPA was 3.0 or higher
- 4. Copy of acceptable teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
- 5. Three (3) letters of recommendation
- 6. Statement of professional goals
- 7. Signed Teacher as Leader Admission Agreement

CURRICULUM CRITERIA

* Every candidate will select course(s) based on his/her SPG with the approval of advisor and graduate program director to strengthen leadership and instructional design and teaching competence.

Individual Competence Development*: Zero to six (0-6) hours Any candidate who has never taken courses in the teaching of reading and /or introduction to special education will be required to do so as a part of this program.

Professional Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours required

Specialization: Fifteen (15) semester hours of LBD courses selected from the list below. If candidate is found to need any individual competence development then those courses will be included in required LBD courses. Additional hours of LBD courses will be required, in addition to Praxis exam required by KYEPSB, to add Learning and Behavior Disorders certification to teaching certificate.
