ADMISSION CRITERIA

Requirements for admission to the Education Specialist in Teaching and Leading as defined by the appropriate catalog include but not limited to:

- Masters Degree in education or in the content are of teacher certification from an accredited institution, with a minimum GPA of a 3.0

- 3. Copy of teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
- 4. Signed Codes of Ethics for Kentucky School Personnel and College of Education

Research Core: Nine (9) semester hours required.

Concentration Core: Twelve (12) semester hours (with prior approval) and in accordance with program requirements or to strengthen the content/concentration of the student.
