ADMISSION CRITERIA

Requirements for admission to the Master of Arts in Education: Teacher as Leader as defined by the appropriate catalog include but not limited to:

- 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 2.75, or a GPA of 3.0 on the last thirty (30) hours of credit completed
- 1. Official Transcripts from all Institutions
- 2. Graduate Record Examination (waived if cumulative undergraduate GPA was 3.0 or higher)
- 3. Supplemental application demonstrating applicant's use of critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration
- 4. Copy of teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
- 5. Signed Teacher as Leader Admission Agreement
- 6. Signed Codes of Ethics for Kentucky School Personnel and College of Education

CURRICULUM CRITERIA

Individual Competence Development: Zero to six (0-6) hours Any MAEd candidate who has never taken courses in the teaching of reading and introduction to special education will be required to do so as a part of this program.

Professional/Research Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours required. At least 15 hours must be taken in courses 600 or above. **Concentration Core:**

- 18 semester hours are required to receive the MATL
- IMPORTANT: 21 semester hours (not including EDS 573) are required for those seeking to sit for the examination to become a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)
