ADMISSION CRITERIA

Requirements for admission to the Master of Arts in Education: Teacher as Leader as defined by the appropriate catalog include but not limited to:

- 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 2.75, or a GPA of 3.0 on the last thirty (30) hours of credit completed
- 1. Official Transcripts from all Institutions
- 2. Graduate Record Examination (waived if cumulative undergraduate GPA was 3.0 or higher)
- 3. Supplemental application demonstrating applicant's use of critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration
- 4. Copy of teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
- 5. Signed Teacher as Leader Admission Agreement
- 6. Signed Codes of Ethics for Kentucky School Personnel and College of Education

CURRICULUM CRITERIA

Individual Competence Development: Zero to six (0-6) hours Any MAEd candidate who has never taken courses in the teaching of reading and introduction to special education will be required to do so as a part of this program.

Professional/Research Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours required. At least 15 hours must be taken in courses 600 or above. Concentration Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours, selected from the following courses, in addition to the professional core to complete degree requirements for the Master of Arts in Education: Teacher as Leader. Any of these courses may be taken and used in the completion of the Master's degree. However, twenty-one (21) semester hours with advisor's prior approval and consisting of the following required and elective courses listed on this contract must be completed, in addition to the mandatory Praxis exam, to add Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education (IECE) Birth-Primary certification. Any substitutions for coursework must be approved by candidate's advisor.
