

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Arts</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Degree requirement for GCTC:

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology:

Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. Students must make a C- or better in all courses. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
