

Associate of Applied Science in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education to Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education – Certification Track

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Applied Science</u> <u>in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education – Certification Track</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Degree requirement for GCTC:

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

Admission Requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education – Certification Track

(Courses in parentheses are GCTC course equivalents)

- A minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COM 181) and ENG 102 (ENG 102)
- A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses which include EDU 300 (EDP 202), EDU 305 (EDU 201), EDU 313 (EDU 204), and EDS 360 (EDP 203).
- Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading (5712) 156 or higher, Writing (5722) – 162 or higher and Mathematics (5732) – 150 or higher
- Pass criminal background check
- 60 semester hours completed
- An acceptable portfolio
- A completed application to the Teacher Education program

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education – Certification Track:

Students majoring in Early Childhood Education – Certification Track must maintain a GPA of 2.75 overall and in major courses in order to enroll in the clinical experience.

At least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
