

### Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Health Communication

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Arts</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Health Communication</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

#### **Degree requirement for GCTC:**

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

#### Admission Requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Health Communication at NKU:

Student must meet pre-requisites for each course, must earn a minimum average GPA 2.0 across all major coursework AND earn at least a C- in each course counted toward the major.

Students majoring in Health Communication must take:

- CMST 101 Public Speaking or CMST 110 Intro to Communication Studies for the General Education Oral Communication requirement
- JOU110 Intro to Mass Communication or INF 128 Principles of Informatics to fulfill the Gen Ed Individual and Society requirement
- SWK 105 Social Work and the Community to fulfill the Gen Ed Cultural Pluralism requirement
- It is recommended students take PSY 100 Intro to Psychology to fulfill the Gen Ed Individual and Society requirement
- It is recommended students take STA 205 Intro to Statistical Methods to fulfill the math Gen Ed requirement

Students should choose a minor. Depending on students' areas of interest, they are encouraged to select a minor that will complement this major and strengthen their skill set. For example, if a student has an interest in video production related to health communication, a minor in Electronic Media and Broadcasting would be appropriate. Students are encouraged to work with their advisor to choose a minor. In some cases, the electives chosen above may also work toward the minor.

Graduation from NKU requires that a student successfully complete a minimum of 120 hours in college-level coursework, 45 of which must be earned at the 300/400 level. Students should work closely with their NKU academic advisor to ensure all major/minor and graduation requirements are fulfilled.
