

Associate in Applied Sciences in Human Services to Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Applied</u> <u>Sciences in Human Services</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Degree requirement for KCTCS:

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions:

Students must successfully complete all required human services and addictions courses and all program-required supportive courses with a grade of *C*- or better and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions. <u>At least 45 credit hours must be</u> <u>300 level or above</u>. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
