

## Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Journalism

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Arts</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Journalism</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

#### **Degree requirement for KCTCS:**

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

#### Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism:

To graduate with a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism, a student must earn 39 credit hours in the major with a grade of C- or above in each course and a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in their major coursework. <u>At least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above.</u> Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
