

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Arts</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Degree requirement for GCTC:

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy:

To graduate with a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy, a student must earn 18 credit hours of required core classes and completion of one 12 credit hour track. At least 18 credit hours must be at 300 level or above. No more than 3 credit hours at the 100 level will count toward the required hours for the major. Students must earn a C- or better in all courses. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU. At least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above. Students must meet the prerequisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
