

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Political Science

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the <u>Associate of Arts</u> degree at Gateway Community and Technical College and leads to the <u>Bachelor of Arts in Political Science</u> degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Degree requirement for GCTC:

1) completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, and 5) demonstration of computer/digital literacy.

Special Admission Requirements:

To declare a major in Political Science, a student must have an earned GPA of least 2.0 in all prior college work.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science:

To graduate with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science, a student must earn 36 credit hours of required classes and 15 hours of political science electives. At least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
