Respond to potential overdoses - and save a life.

Use of heroin or opioids, or drugs laced with these substances, increase the risk for overdose. If someone has overdosed, **FIRST CALL 911**. If you have been trained, perform CPR. Nalaxone (Narcan) can reverse an opioid overdose. If someone you know is at risk for an opioid overdose, you may want a nalaxone kit. *Visit trdhd.com for locations*.



Injection drug use increases a person's risk of becoming infected with hepatitis C and HIV.

Syringe access exchange programs are tools to reduce the threat of infectious disease spread through drug injection equipment, as well as a way to connect people who inject drugs to treatment resources and other health services.
