## Call 9-1-1 Immediately for Sudden & Life Threatening Injury/Illness

Drug overdose  
Difficulty breathing  
Constant chest pain  
Drowning  
Electrocution  
Choking  
Severe burns

Gunshot wounds  
Convulsions/seizures  
Allergic reaction  
New severe headache  
Sudden intense pain  
Diabetic emergency  
Poisoning

Colds/flu  
Earache  
Sore throat/cough  
Minor accidents  
Minor sprains  
Minor cuts  
Fever

Mild vomiting/diarrhea
