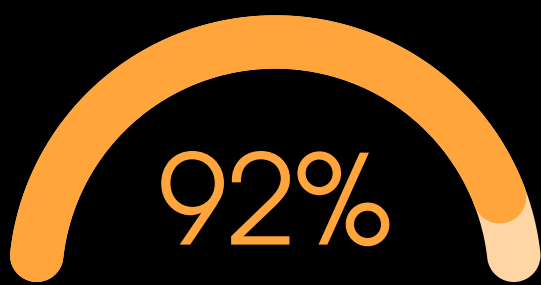
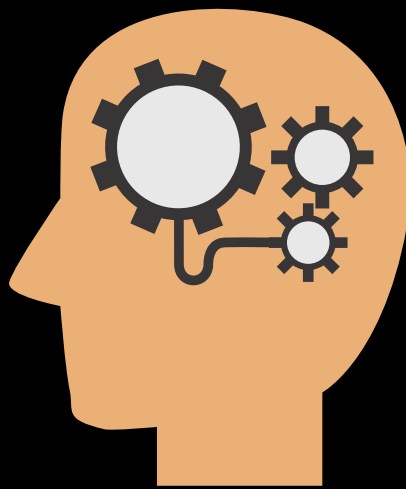


THE IMPACT OF INFORMATION LITERACY MODULES

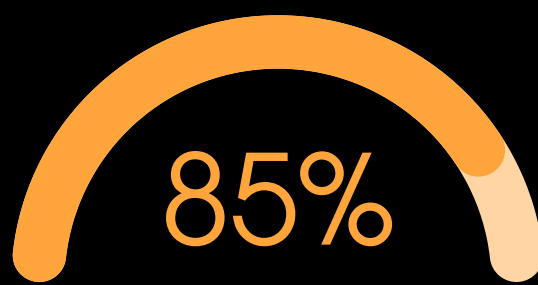
Steely librarians collaborated with faculty to embed GEAR concepts into Canvas courses during the 2020/2021 academic year. More than 700 students completed the modules. Ranging from first year students to graduate students, the results show the modules are significantly impactful for all students as they develop their information literacy skills.

LEARNED NEW CONCEPTS

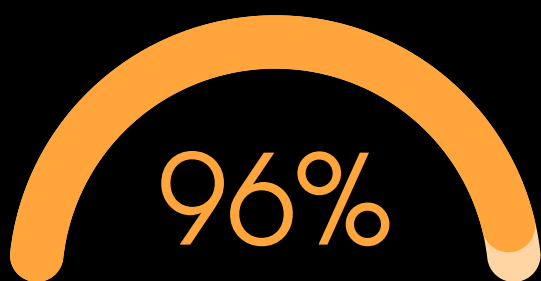
92% of students agreed or strongly agreed with the statement "I learned something new that will help me **succeed** in my classes.."

RAISED CONFIDENCE

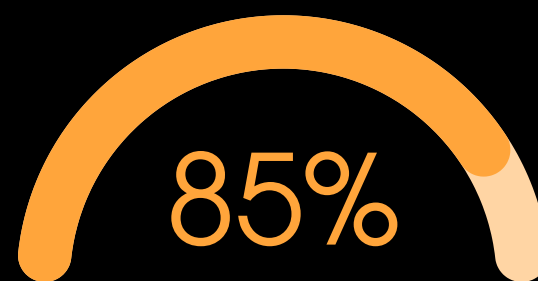
85% of students agreed or strongly agreed with the statement "I feel more confident about **completing my assignments.**"
