# TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2025-2026

Associate of Applied Science in Construction Management Technology at Sinclair College to a

Bachelor of Science in Construction Management at Northern Kentucky University

#### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Construction Management Technology degree at Sinclair College and leads to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Construction Management degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

#### Degree Requirements for Sinclair College

To earn a degree at Sinclair College, a student must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, complete state and college requirements, and earn a minimum of 20 credit hours at Sinclair College.

#### **Admission Requirements for NKU**

Students completing an associate degree at Sinclair with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

#### Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0 and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major. Students must earn a grade of C or better in all construction management core courses.
