
After the sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawn-ing, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary




went to see the tomb. **2** And sud-den-ly there was a great earth-quake; for an angel of the Lord, de -




scending from heaven, came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. **3** His ap-pear-ance was like



light-ning, and his clothing white as snow. **4** For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead




men. **5** But the an-gel said to the wom-en, “Do not be a-fraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus




who was cru-ci-fied. **6** He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where




he lay. **7** Then go quick-ly and tell his dis-ci-ples, ‘He has been raised from the dead, and indeed he




is go-ing a-head of you to Gal - i - lee; there you will see him.’ This is my message for you.” **8** So




they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his dis-ci-ples. 9 Sud-den-ly Je-sus
