
Just then a lawyer stood up to test Je-sus. “Teacher,” he said, “what must I do to in - her - it e -




ter - nal life?” *26* He said to him, “What is writ-ten in the law? What do you read there?” *27* He an-



swered, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all




your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as your-self.” *28* And he said to him, “You




have giv-en the right an-swer; do this, and you will live.”




29 But want-ing to jus-ti - fy him-self, he asked Je-sus, “And who is my neigh-bor?” *30* Je-sus re -




plied, “A man was going down from Je- ru-sa-lem to Jer - i - cho, and fell into the hands of robbers,




who stripped him, beat him, and went away, leaving him half dead. *31* Now by chance a priest was




going down that road; and when he saw him, he passed by on the oth-er side. 32 So likewise a Le -




vite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the oth-er side. 33 But a Samaritan while



traveling came near him; and when he saw him, he was moved with pit - y. 34 He went to him and




ban-daged his wounds, having poured oil and wine on them. Then he put him on his own animal,




brought him to an inn, and took care of him. 35 The next day he took out two denarii, gave them




to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever
