Someone in the crowd said to Jesus, “Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family in-her - i - tance



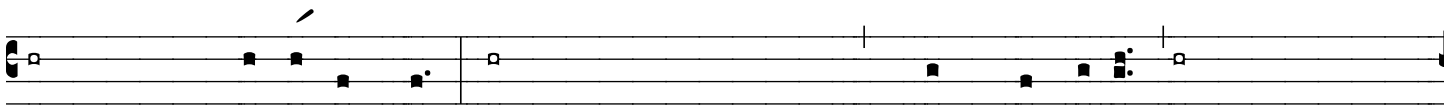

not consist in the abundance of pos-ses-sions.” <sup>16</sup> Then he told them a par- a-ble: “The land of a rich



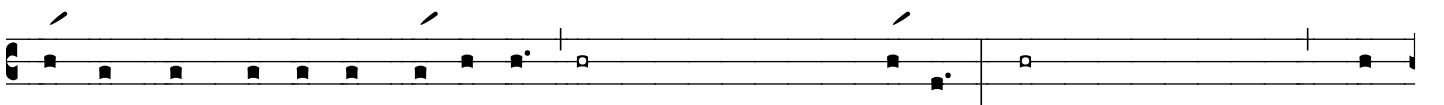
man produced a-bun-dant-ly. <sup>17</sup> And he thought to himself, ‘What should I do, for I have no place



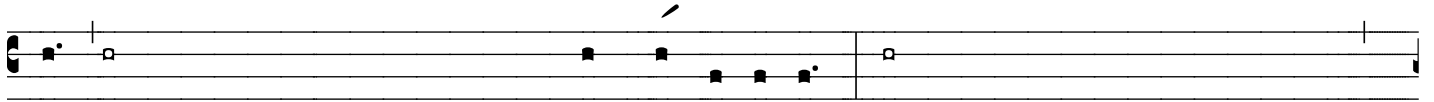
to store my crops?’ <sup>18</sup> Then he said, ‘I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larg - er



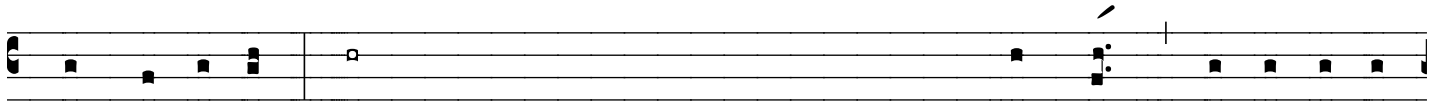
ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. <sup>19</sup> And I will say to my soul, ‘Soul, you have
