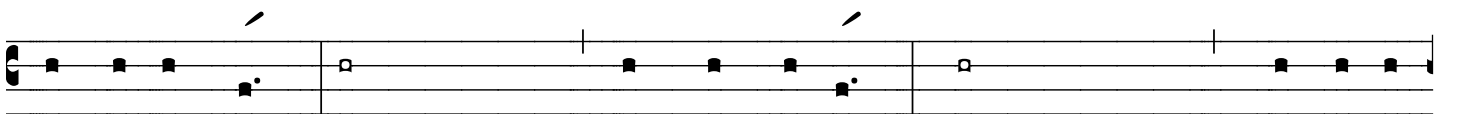
On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Gal-i - lee. **12** As



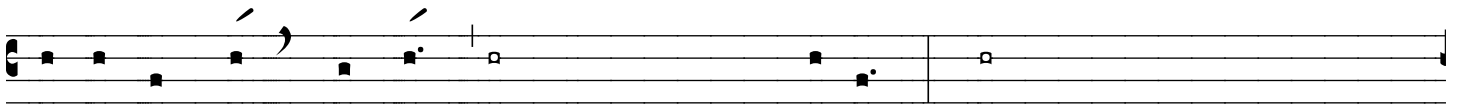
he entered a village, ten lepers ap-proached him. Keeping their distance, **13** they called out, say-ing,



“Jesus, Master, have mer-cy on us!” **14** When he saw them, he said to them, “Go and show your -



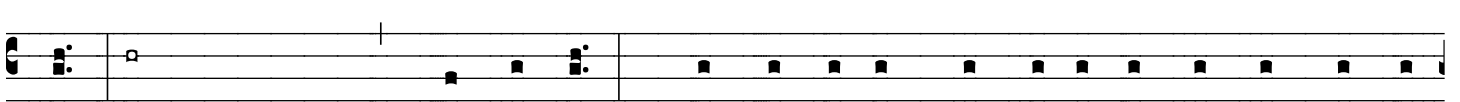
selves to the priests.” And as they went, they were made clean. **15** Then one of them, when he saw



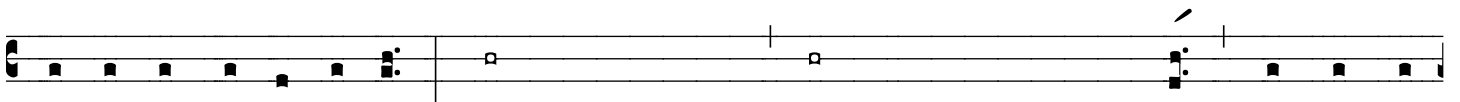
that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. **16** He prostrated himself at Jesus’
