



✠ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je - sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Luke. ✠ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.*




When they came to the place that is called The Skull, they cru - ci - fied Je-sus there with the




crim-i-nals, one on his right and one on his left. ³⁴ Then Jesus said, “Fa-ther, for-give them; for



they do not know what they are do-ing.” And they cast lots to divide his cloth-ing. ³⁵ And the




people stood by, watching; but the lead-ers scoffed at him, say-ing, “He saved oth-ers; let him




save him-self if he is the Mes-si-ah of God, his chos-en one!” ³⁶ The soldiers also mocked




him, com-ing up and of-fer-ing him sour wine, ³⁷ and say-ing, “If you are the King of the Jews,




save your-self!” ³⁸ There was also an inscription over him, “This is the King of the Jews.” ³⁹ One




of the criminals who were hanged there kept de-rid-ing him and say-ing, “Are you not the




Mes- si- ah? Save your-self and us!” 40 But the oth-er re-buked him, say-ing, “Do you not fear



God, since you are un-der the same sen-tence of con-dem-na-tion? 41 And we in-deed have been




con-demned just-ly, for we are get-ting what we de-serve for our deeds, but this man has done
