
other way is a thief and a ban-dit. 2 The one who enters by the gate is the shep-herd of the sheep.




3 The gate-keep-er o - pens the gate for him, and the sheep hear his voice. He calls his own sheep




by name and leads them out. 4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and
