
fied you on earth by finishing the work that you gave me to do. <sup>5</sup> So now, Father, glorify me in




your own presence with the glory that I had in your presence before the world ex-ist-ed. <sup>6</sup> “I




have made your name known to those whom you gave me from the world. They were yours,




and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. **7** Now they know that everything you



have giv-en me is from you; **8** for the words that you gave to me I have given to them, and they




have received them and know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you




sent me. **9** I am ask-ing on their be-half; I am not asking on behalf of the world, but on be-half
