
When the sab-bath was o-ver, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Sa-lo-me bought spi-ces,




so that they might go and a-noint him. **2** And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had ris-en,




they went to the tomb. **3** They had been say-ing to one an-oth-er, “Who will roll a-way the stone for us from




the en-trance to the tomb?” **4** When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had al-




read-y been rolled back. **5** As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man, dressed in a white robe, sit-ting on



the right side; and they were a-larmed. **6** But he said to them, “Do not be a - larmed; you are looking for Je-




sus of Nazareth, who was cru - ci - fied. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid
